





Getting a lot of paid shows is unlikely at an early stage. Consumers don't really buy music either. On the bright side, due to this age of social media, artists can easily connect with fans, and build their own audience. I think Atlanta is doing a great job at offering a variety of music events where artists are given the opportunity to perform. I believe that offering more paid performance opportunities, which have the artists' best interest in mind, would be very beneficial.
